



EKC Facility Rental – Frequently Asked Questions

1. How does pricing work?

Pricing is determined by length of stay, number of guests, use of facilities, programming, food service, special requests and more. Pricing is usually given at per person rate but can vary depending on event.

2. When is camp available to rent?

Camp is available to rent year-round, except during our summer program which typically runs mid-June through early August. Programming and Housing available depends on the time of year. Aquatics activities (lake and pool) are available early May through late September, weather dependent. Housing and programming is limited in the winter months. Rental dates fill up fast. We recommend contacting us as much as a year in advance if possible.

3. How many people can stay at camp during a retreat?

Camp has Housing for approximately 500 people in the fall, spring and summer months and approximately 65 people in the winter months. Currently capacity is limited by the COVID West Virginia camping guidelines. Please contact us directly for more information.

4. What are the housing accommodations like at camp?

There are a variety of different housing accommodations available for rental groups including our camper cabins with bathrooms attached, platforms tents with a bathhouse, our Beit Chosky Lodge with community bathrooms and central air/heat, and traditional housing with full sized kitchens, central air/hear and laundry. 5. Can we rent camp for the just the day?

Yes, camp can be rented for just the day!

6. Can more than one group rent camp at the same time?

Yes, more than one group can rent camp at the same time, depending on the size of the groups, and the programming and facility needs for each group. Exclusivity is also an option for groups.

7. How does food service work?

EKC employs a professional food service company to provide our meals. Our tasty and nutritious menu offers a wide variety of breakfast, lunch, dinner and snack options to choose from. Rental groups can work directly with our food service provider to design the ideal menu for their group. All food served at EKC is prepared in accordance with the Jewish dietary laws of kashrut (kosher). EKC is well equipped to handle all special dietary needs. We are prepared for a variety of diets including vegetarian, gluten free, diabetic and lactose intolerant as well as other allergy restrictions. We also have a separate gluten-free kitchen and serving window to accommodate gluten-free individuals.

8. Can Rental Groups cater/cook their own food at camp?

Yes, rental groups can prepare their own food at camp or have their event catered by a company of their choosing. If preparing their own food, groups may have access to our Camper Kitchen which is equipped with two residential fridges, ovens and stovetops along with most other household kitchen appliances. However, EKC's Dining Hall is a kosher facility and only food prepared accordingly may be eaten inside the Dining Hall.

9. Is there internet available at camp?

Yes, internet is available at camp in our Dining Hall and Camp Office. As more people are using the internet around camp, connection can become quite slow. As an alternative, we do have Wi-Fi Hot Spots available to rent that can be used anywhere around camp.

10. Is there laundry available at camp?

Yes, there are laundry machines available in our Health Center and each our three new houses are equipped with washers and dryers.


11. What activities are available for Rental Groups?

All of camp's activities except Horseback Riding are available, depending on the time of year. Some of camp's most popular activities for rental groups include swimming in the pools and at the lake, tubing, Ropes Course, Sports and Archery, Arts & Crafts and Ceramics.
